The Custer JR/SR High School will again be using our program, ICU, to help fight student apathy and raise classroom expectations for the year. The ICU program is designed to make sure each and every student learns the material presented in every class. The goal is to create accountability with students and have them complete every assignment to a satisfactory level.

- ICU time is incorporated into the day. The main time for this will be at the end of the day during “Wildcat Time”, which is a common period for all students and teachers.
- Students are assigned to the ICU list by their teachers. Students may be put on the list because they gone and missed assignments, or if they turned in assignments that were done very poorly.
- ICU time is not a detention or punishment, but instead an opportunity! ICU is a time for students to receive extra help/teaching and show their mastery of learning standards in classes.
- Parental support and involvement in the children’s education has been shown to have a tremendous effect on their overall success in school. Ask to see your students’ homework and assignments.
- Above all, please project a positive attitude toward ICU and its intention-to HELP the student, not to punish the student (or parent) if the work is not completed on time or poorly completed.
